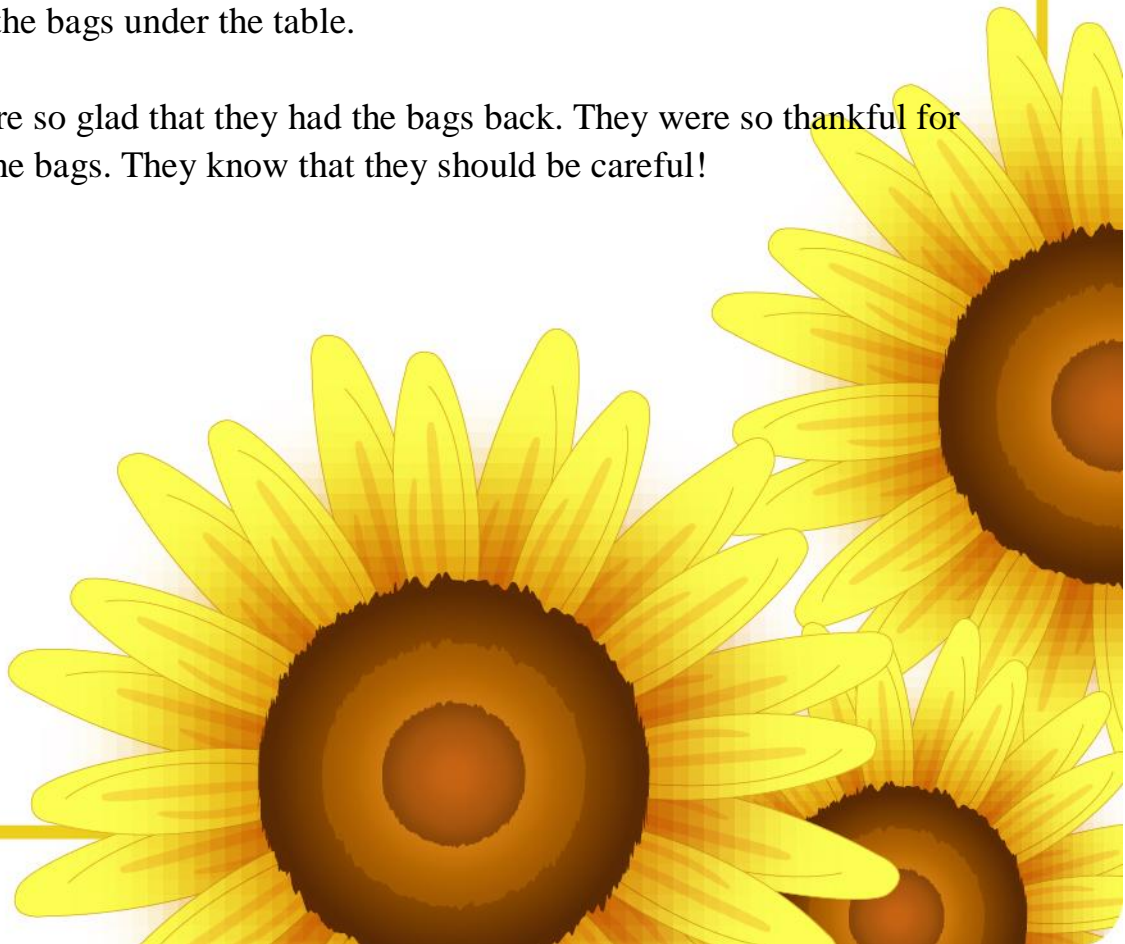

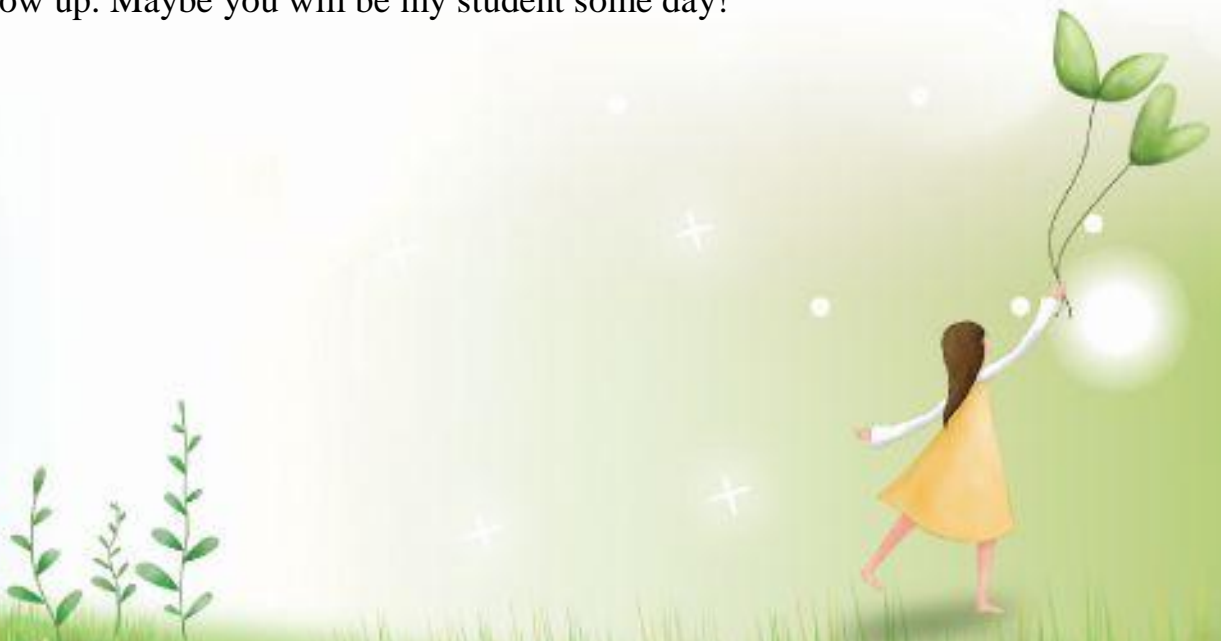
My Dream Job

Find the Treasure Box!

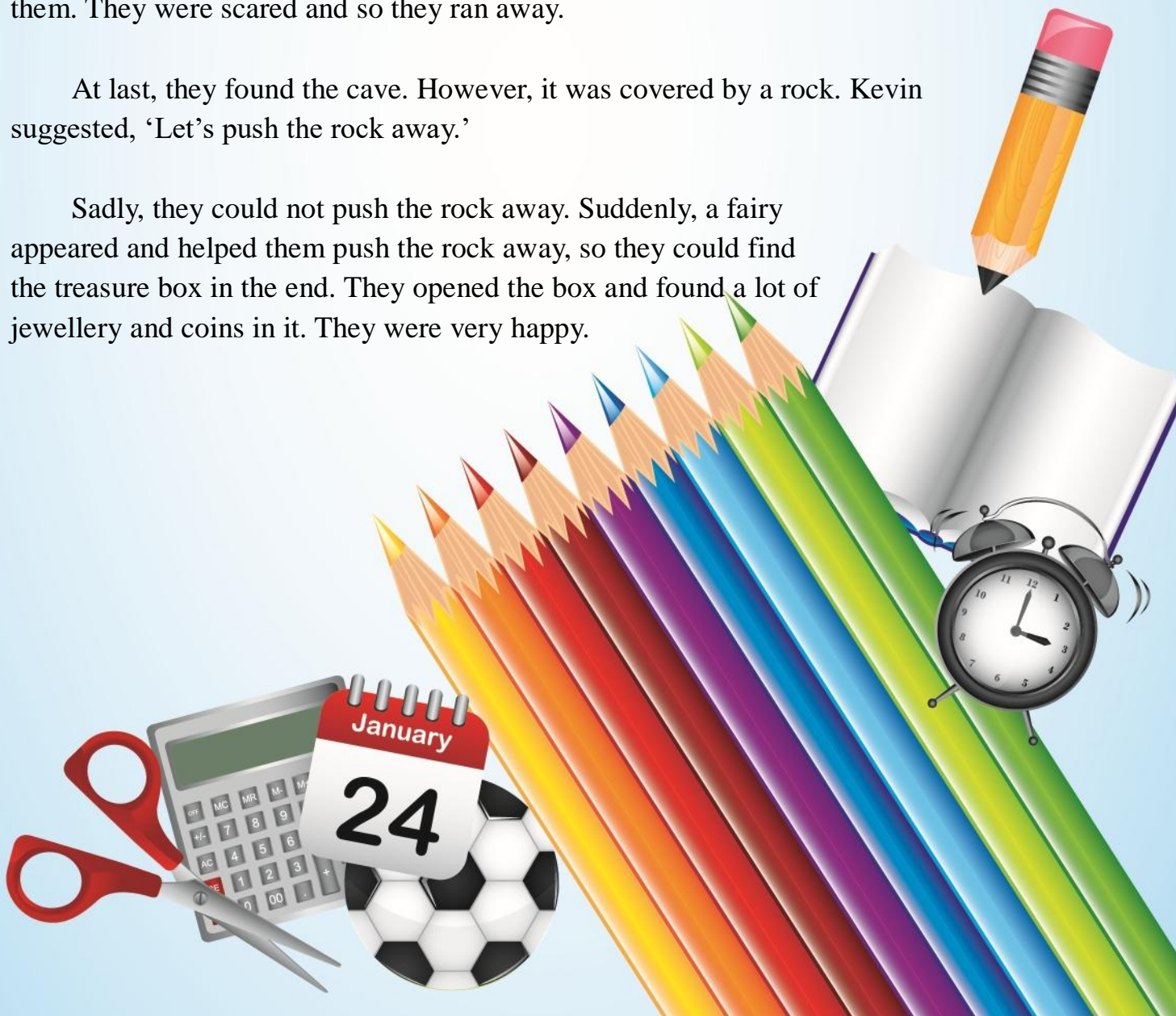
Once upon a time, there were two explorers called Dan and Kevin. They were finding a treasure box in a cave in a forest. They were excited.
